



LANGUAGE GALA 2021- TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1.0 OBJECTIVE

PPBLT Language Gala 2021 is a language contest to encourage USM students to produce quality assignments and to submit the assignments by the due date given. Best assignments will be rewarded with prizes.

2.0 ELIGIBILITY & PARTICIPATION

- 2.1 All language proficiency students are automatically eligible to participate in the contest and it is free of charge. Students who do not want to participate may inform the class teacher of the respective course.
- 2.2 Courses involved are proficiency courses such as LKM, LMT, LSP, LHP, LDN and all foreign language courses (option and minor).
- 2.3 Each course should have at least 25 students to be eligible to participate in the contest.
- 2.4 Each course leader(KP) will choose ONE (1) assessment to be used in the contest. For example: *Individual Oral Presentation* (LSP401)
- 2.5 All assignments submitted must be the student's original work. As this is part of the coursework, the assignments received are confidential and shall not be shared with the public.

3.0 CONTEST MECHANISM

- 3.1 Each class teacher must choose ONE(1) best assignment and forward it to the course leader (KP).
- 3.2 The course leader(KP) and assistants(PKP) for each course must collect all the assignments to be judged and then select the top 3 assignments. For example, if there are 50 groups of LMT 100, the course leader(KP) and assistants(PKP) will receive 50 Individual Oral Presentation videos to be judged.
- 3.3 If the course only has one or two group(s) but still qualify with the minimum of 25 students, the three winners will still be selected from this one or two groups.
- 3.4 As for courses at Engineering and Health campuses, the selection of the best assignments is done by the branch campuses and the best assignments from each group should be sent to the respective course leader(KP) at the main campus.
- 3.5 The course leader(KP) and assistants(PKP) will only request for the student's details if he/she wins the contest and the organiser takes reasonable precautions to keep the student's personal data secure.

4.0 PRIZES

* Each course (minimum of 25 students and more) will have THREE (3) winners.
* All winners will be notified via email or/and phone.

5.0 IMPORTANT DATES

- 5.1. The last day for assignment submission adheres strictly to the deadline given in the course outline.
- 5.2. The last day to submit the top three assignments to the organiser is on the **30th July 2021 (Tuesday)**.
- 5.3. Winners will be announced in August.
