Introduction

- The Arabic Courses are for individuals who are interested to continue or to improve their proficiency in Arabic during a short term in Universiti Sains Malaysia, Penang.

Objective

- The objective of this course is to help students achieve a higher level of communicative competence that will allow them to interact in everyday life situations.

Content

- Greeting, talking and asking about the identity of people (name, age, origin, profession, marital status and place of living), introducing people, describing people and expressing everyday life situations.

Entry Level

- Beginners
- Minimum age: 16 and above

Duration

- 5 weeks (10 sessions)
- Total: 20 contact hours
- Date: 9 July 2018 – 10 Aug 2018

- Tuesday and Thursday, 5pm – 7pm

Venue

- Building D09/Room 215, School of Languages, Literacies and Translation

Fee

- RM600 per person/course (inclusive of materials)
