- The USM Security Department has made revisions to the operating hours of the entrances to facilitate the movement of staff, students as well as daily operations of the University.

	BATU UBAN	(Monday - Friday) Working days only (6.00 am - 7.00 pm)	Entrance and exit in operation. (Staff only)
	MINDEN	(Monday - Friday) Working days only (6.30 am - 9.00 am) (12.00 pm - 3.00 pm)	Entrance and exit in operation. (Staff only)

- The operating hours will be effective beginning **Monday, 1 March 2021** and will be subject to developments from time to time.

Throughout this Movement Control Order (MCO) period, all students are urged to always practice self-monitoring including physical distancing, wearing a face mask, frequent washing of hands with soap and water or using a hand sanitizer, in addition to taking care of their health as preventive measures against being infected.
