- A communicative approach is utilised in the course's teaching and learning process, coupled with the use of the most up-to-date audio-visual technology available.

Objective

• The objective is to help students achieve a measure of basic communicative competence that will allow them to interact comfortably in everyday situations.

Content

 Greetings, conversing about identities (e.g. name, age, country of origin, profession, marital status and languages spoken), introductions, describing people, common expressions, placing orders at restaurant and making room reservations.

Beginners

Minimum age: 16 and above

Duration

• 8 weeks (4 hours per week)

Total: 32 contact hours (30 hours of lessons + 2 hours of assessment)
